WORKSHOP DESCRIPTION:

Session 1:

Getting to Know Proloquo2Go: An AAC Solution for the iPhone and iPod Touch

This presentation will provide an overview of an innovative new augmentative communication application for the iPhone/iPod touch.

Learning Outcomes:

1. Participants will learn the unique features of Proloquo2Go, and the basic programming of the software.
2. Participants will learn who can use Proloquo2Go, and how to implement Proloquo2go as a communication tool.

Session 2:

School-Based Articulation Services: A Response to Intervention Model

This presentation discusses school-based articulation services, and how to implement a tier 2 service delivery model following the response to intervention mandate. Participants will learn to approach administration, set up a schedule, and implement efficient therapeutic practices to reduce workload. Therapists will be given ready-to-use materials to assist in planning and implementing a speech improvement class.

Learning Outcomes:

1. Participants will learn how to service single sound articulation error students as part of a tier 2 response to intervention, and how to fit RTI into their therapy schedule.
2. Participants will learn how to implement ready-to-use materials and techniques they can use in therapy.

PRESENTERS:

Melanie Rivera, M.S., CCC-SLP works full time as a speech language pathologist in the Dry Creek Joint Elementary School District. She received her B.A in communicative disorders and her M.S. in speech language pathology from the University of Redlands. Melanie has gained recognition in her local network for sharing her experience in transitioning from a full caseload of IEP students to a combination of special education and school based services under the guidelines of RTI. Her real-world, practical approach includes materials to present to administrators and easy to implement therapy techniques.

Betsy Caporale, M.S., CCC-SLP, AAC/AT Specialist, received her Master's degree in Speech-Language Pathology from California State University, Hayward. She is a Certified Assistive Technology Specialist, and received her Certificate of Competency in Communication Assistive Technology Applications from the National Association of State Directors of Special Education. Betsy has worked in the field of speech-language pathology for almost 20 years, serving a variety of populations across settings, including schools, hospitals and clinics. She has a particularly strong background in autism, augmentative communication, and assistive technology. These continue to be areas of special interest for her. Currently, she is employed by the California Department of Education, Northern California Diagnostic Center as a Speech-Language Pathologist, AAC/AT Specialist.
