Gail Wilson Lew, M.A., CCC-SLP, has been a speech-language pathologist in a variety of settings, including the public school, home health, and hospitals. For the past 19 years she has had a private practice where she specializes in children and adults who stutter. Gail teaches the undergraduate fluency class and the online graduate class, as well as supervise a stuttering clinic, at California State University, Northridge. Gail was a facilitator of the Los Angeles County-Pasadena Chapter of the National Stuttering Association for 14 years, and has conducted numerous workshops for children who stutter and their families. Gail has published articles and has authored a children's book on stuttering. Gail was once a severe stut-terer and is an American Speech-Language-Hearing Association (ASHA) board recognized fluency specialist. She has presented at California Speech-Language-Hearing Association (CSHA), ASHA, and several school districts.
