## Successful RPE/CFY Supervision

### *Course Description*

This course will review the guidelines for the Required Professional Experience (RPE) as mandated by the California Speech-Language Pathology and Audiology Licensing Board (SLPAB). The morning session content will focus on knowledge and skills required by speech-language pathologists who are supervising RPEs for the first time. The afternoon session will build on supervisory skills needed to move from supervision to mentoring and maximize job satisfaction. Participants can register for the whole day (6.0 CE Hours) or the afternoon only (3.0 CE Hours).

### *Course Objectives*

By the end of the course, participants will be able to:

1. Follow the guidelines for supervision as outlined by the State of California SLPAB for supervision of an RPE candidate.
2. Identify and complete all required applications used throughout the RPE.
3. Demonstrate understanding of the basic tenets of supervision and mentoring.
4. Utilize the appropriate model of supervision for the RPE SLP/AuD
5. Identify differences in values, problem solving and communication styles between the generations.
