

**California Speech-Language-Hearing Association's
Guidelines for the Diagnosis & Treatment
for Auditory Processing Disorders
Approved January 2007**

This final version of the 2007 (C)APD document was approved by the CSHA Board of Directors January 20, 2007. Some of the highlights, including the repaginated Table of Contents are listed below, with the complete document following.

- 1) Incorporated information from the ASHA Technical Report so that the terminology is consistent
- 2) Updated the preferred test batteries for the audiologist and SLP to reflect the ASHA position
- 3) Replaced references to "bilingual children" to "Children from Linguistically and Culturally Diverse Backgrounds"
- 4) Incorporated Response to Intervention strategies and terminology
- 5) Removed information in the first section which indicated ASHA had not addressed certain issues (such as performing assessments within the hearing-impaired populations, etc.) since they were in fact clarified in the ASHA document
- 6) Changed "CAPD" and "APD" to the ASHA-preferred "(C)APD"
- 7) Updated references & pagination
