Other recent policy work includes advocating for:

- Restoration of proposed statewide cuts to Early Intervention therapy programs.
- Creation of Doctor of Audiology (AuD) programs at five schools in the California State University (CSU) system.
- Increased numbers of graduate speech pathology slots in the CSU system.
- Governor's appointment of a CSHA board member to the state licensing board to provide a strong voice for members and improved coordination.
