

Advocacy Update Regarding Proposed Changes to CPT® Code 92507

A proposal has been issued to replace CPT® code 92507 with new time-based treatment codes beginning in 2027.

Because this change could affect how speech-language therapy services are described, documented, and delivered, clinicians and professional organizations are closely reviewing the proposal and providing feedback.

What is the California Speech Language Hearing Association Doing?

- We are actively reviewing and discussing the proposed changes with the California Speech Language Hearing Association (CSHA) advocacy team.
- CSHA is engaging in the American Medical Association (AMA) CPT® code change processes and monitoring developments closely.
- We are preparing a formal CSHA position statement on the proposed changes.
- CSHA representatives will attend the upcoming AMA CPT® Editorial Panel Meeting to provide feedback on behalf of our members.
